

## Day 1: Arrival and Kotor Old Town



Start Time: 12:00 PM

End Time: 08:00 PM

Arrive in Montenegro and settle into the charming coastal town of Kotor. Spend the afternoon wandering the cobbled streets of Kotor Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site enclosed by towering fortress walls. Discover the Romanesque St. Tryphons Cathedral, visit the Maritime Museum, and admire the intricate stonework of centuries-old homes. For sunset, walk partway up the San Giovanni Fortress trail for sweeping views of the Bay of Kotor. End the evening with a traditional Montenegrin dinner along the waterfront promenade.

## Day 2: Bay of Kotor Adventure

Start Time: 09:00 AM

End Time: 07:00 PM

Take a morning boat tour across the Bay of Kotor. Stop at Our Lady of the Rocks, a tiny man-made islet with a legendary church, and explore the baroque town of Perast. In the afternoon, go sea kayaking or paddleboarding through the peaceful waters, surrounded by mountains and dotted villages. Wrap up your day with fresh seafood at a bay-view restaurant.

## Day 3: Budva Riviera



Start Time: 10:00 AM

End Time: 06:00 PM

Relax and unwind on the glamorous Budva Riviera. Begin your day at Mogren Beach, a secluded cove perfect for swimming and sunbathing. Visit the iconic Sveti Stefan viewpoint for postcard-worthy photos. Explore Budvas lively Old Town with its Venetian walls, quaint squares, and local art galleries. Try parasailing or rent a jet ski for a burst of adrenaline. Evening in Budva offers lively nightlife or a serene seaside meal.

## Day 4: Lovcen National Park and Njegusi Village



Start Time: 08:00 AM

End Time: 06:00 PM

Drive the scenic serpentine road from Kotor to Lovcen National Park, passing through breathtaking switchbacks with panoramic views. Hike to the Mausoleum of Petar II Petrovic-Njegos, perched atop Mount Lovcen, and enjoy the striking vistas across the country. Visit Njegusi Village for local delicacies like smoked prosciutto and sheep cheese. This area offers a blend of cultural heritage and natural beauty.

## Day 5: Cetinje and Lipa Cave



Start Time: 09:00 AM

End Time: 05:00 PM

Spend the morning in Cetinje, the historical royal capital of Montenegro. Visit the King Nikolas Palace, the National Museum, and the Cetinje Monastery. After lunch, take a guided adventure into Lipa Cave, one of Montenegros largest karst caves, filled with stalactites, stalagmites, and underground wonders. Return in the evening for a relaxing dinner and local wine tasting.

## Day 6: Durmitor National Park

Start Time: 07:00 AM

End Time: 08:00 PM

Travel to northern Montenegro to discover Durmitor National Park. Begin your adventure with a hike around the glacial Black Lake, then head to the Tara River for one of Europe's most thrilling whitewater rafting experiences. Optional zip-lining across the Tara Canyon adds extra excitement. Overnight in the mountain town of Zabljak with a cozy dinner in a rustic alpine inn.

## Day 7: Ulcinj and Ada Bojana



Start Time: 09:00 AM

End Time: 07:00 PM

Venture south to Ulcinj, a historic town known for its Ottoman architecture, sandy beaches, and multicultural vibe. Spend time exploring the old fortress, relaxing on Velika Plaza (the Great Beach), or trying out windsurfing. In the late afternoon, head to Ada Bojana, a river island paradise perfect for sunset dining and nature immersion. Enjoy a seafood dinner at a stilted restaurant over the Bojana River.

## Day 8: Fly Fishing in Plav



Start Time: 07:00 AM

End Time: 05:00 PM

Journey to the northeastern town of Plav, nestled at the foot of the Prokletije Mountains. Spend the day fly fishing in the pristine Lim and Ljuca rivers, renowned for their abundance of grayling, brown trout, rainbow trout, and the elusive huchen (also known as Danube salmon or taimen). With crystal-clear waters, a peaceful alpine setting, and expert local guides available, this day offers a perfect escape into nature for both seasoned anglers and curious first-timers. Enjoy a riverside picnic with locally sourced food and soak in the serenity before returning to your lodge or heading toward your departure point.

## Day 9: Podgorica and Lake Skadar



Start Time: 08:00 AM

End Time: 06:00 PM

Begin your final day with a tranquil boat ride on Lake Skadar, rich in birdlife and traditional fishing villages. Later, visit Podgorica's landmarks like the Millennium Bridge, Ribnica Fortress, and the impressive Cathedral of the Resurrection. Cap off the journey with a wine tasting at Plantaze, one of the largest vineyards in Europe, before departure.
